## ACE SKI & BOARD CLUB •••• 2005/2006 SEASON LIFT TICKET PURCHASE TERMS & CONDITIONS

Please review the following information outlining the 2005/2006 Membership requirements for ticket purchase and the general terms and conditions of purchase.

- TICKET PROGRAMS:** The ACE SKI & Board Club Benefits Committee is responsible for the sale of discounted lift tickets. Discounted lift tickets are purchased by the ACE Ski & Board Club from the Ski New Hampshire ([www.skinh.com](http://www.skinh.com)) and the Vermont Ski Areas Association ([www.skivermont.com](http://www.skivermont.com)) discounted lift ticket programs. Tickets are offered for sale to Adult Members of the ACE Ski & Board Club NE over 21 years old for use during the current ski season. Please read disclaimer of ticket purchase and use on the 2005/2006 Ticket Order Form (Paragraph above where you sign). Ski NH tickets have no restricted use dates. Vermont tickets have various restricted use dates – usually at Christmas/New Year's, Martin Luther King weekend and the February school vacation week. Restricted use dates are subject to yearly change by the resorts and the ACE Ski & Board Club does not know in advance of its purchase what dates are restricted.
- MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:** To buy discounted lift tickets, you must be 21 years or older and a member of the ACE Ski & Board Club for the 2005/2006 season with annual membership dues **paid**. If you are not a **paid** Member, your ticket order will **NOT** be fulfilled. Please contact Jean O'Donnell ([wienerin1900@yahoo.com](mailto:wienerin1900@yahoo.com)) regarding your Membership status or visit the Membership table at the next meeting to join or renew your Membership.
- TICKET PURCHASE METHOD:** Lift Tickets will be available for sale (on a first come/first serve basis) through a Mail Sale, beginning August 15<sup>th</sup> through August 29<sup>th</sup>. Ticket purchases postmarked before August 15<sup>th</sup> or after August 29<sup>th</sup> will be returned. Tickets purchased through the Mail Sale will be distributed at club meetings or via US Certified mail. Ticket prices do **not** include mailing costs. Mountains have been divided into three tiers this year. Restrictions are as follows: 8 ticket maximum with a 2 ticket maximum per mountain on Tier #1, 8 ticket maximum with a 4 ticket maximum per mountain on Tier #2 unless no tier #1 tickets were ordered then it is a 12 ticket maximum with a 4 ticket maximum per mountain on tier #2. There is a 16 Ticket maximum with 4 tickets maximum per mountain on tier #3 tickets this year. There will be a second mail sale with those tickets available which have not sold out in the first mail sale or at the September 15<sup>th</sup> General Club Meeting. **One order form must be submitted for each club member.** After Dec 6<sup>th</sup>, club members can purchase as many tickets and for as many mountains as desired. Tickets will also be available for purchase without restrictions at the Dec 6<sup>th</sup> meeting. **All orders MUST include a check for the total amount of your order.** Please make checks payable to the ACE Ski & Board Club. - TICKET PAYMENTS:** The ACE Ski & Board Club only accepts personal checks and money orders for payment of tickets. Cash, credit card, debit card, or other payment options are **NOT** accepted. Payment, in full, is due at time of purchase. **All ticket sales are final. Refunds or returns are NOT available.**
- TICKET PICKUP at Meetings:** The preferred method for distributing is at club meetings. Tickets should be available at the Dec 6<sup>th</sup> ski club general meeting.
- Mailing Lift Tickets:** To have tickets mailed, enclose with your order a certified self-addressed stamped envelope with a completed PS Form 3800 and a completed PS Form 3811. Note: You must request \$4.42 worth of stamps for the certified stamped envelope; do **not** use PVI (you cannot use a single sticker worth \$4.42 because it is dated).

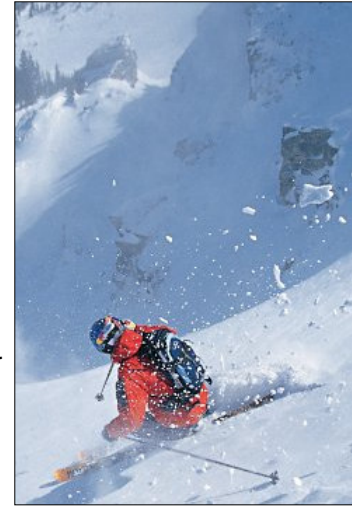

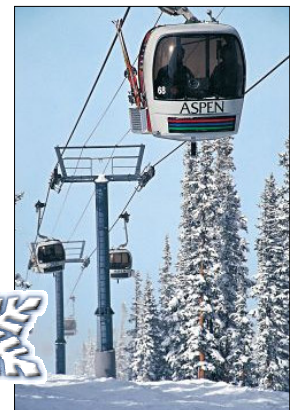
